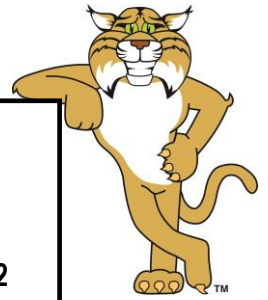

- Open House- Thursday, August 24, 2017, at 5:00 p.m.

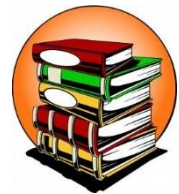
