Per Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 392.4644, a principal, in consultation with site administration, licensed personnel, support professionals, and parents and/or guardians of students from the school, shall annually review the *Clark County School District K-12 Student Code of Conduct*.

Goal I: All students will increase proficiency in math from 75% to 78% as measured by state summative assessment.

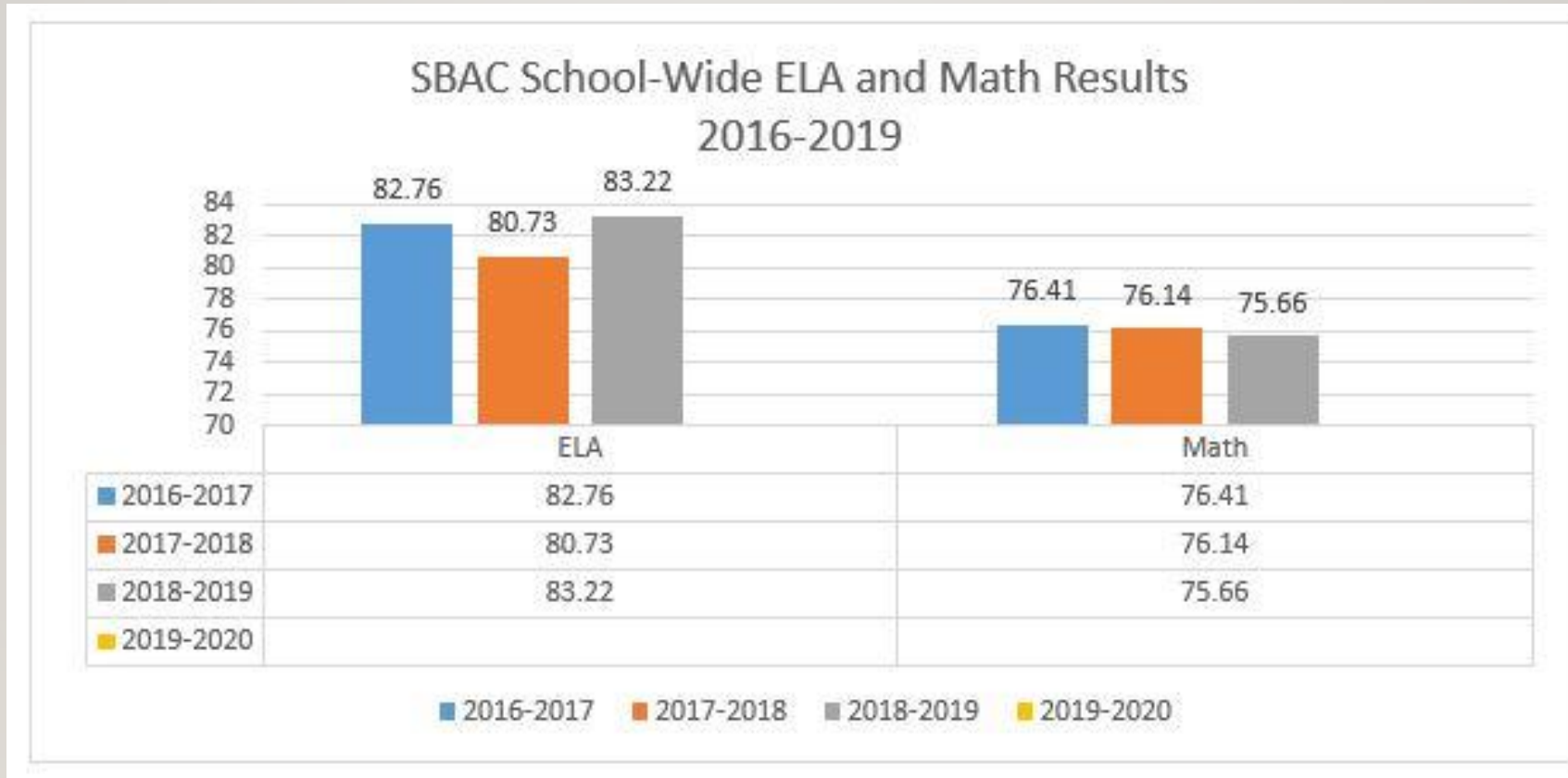
