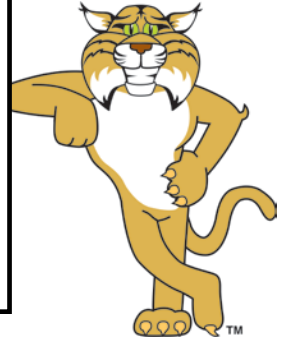

Access SBAC Practice Test from Home: Parents can view a practice test online by logging onto www.smarterbalanced.org. Once on this page, click on the “Assessments” tab in the bar at the top, and then click on “Practice and Sample Questions.” Select Nevada as your location. Click on Online Tools Training under Summative. On the next screen, select either English Language Arts or Mathematics. Then select Grades 3-5. Sign in using the Username and Password provided on the screen.

Testing Calendar: SBAC Exam – Grades 3-5: All students in grades 3-5 will continue taking the Criterion Referenced Test (SBAC) through May 15, 2019. The SBAC is a state developed criterion-referenced test that measures the achievement of students relative to the Nevada Academic Content Standards.

We implemented ***School-Wide Quiet Hours starting March 26, 2019 from 8:00-11:00 a.m. each day.*** It is important that there are no interruptions within the classrooms during these dates and times. We will be adjusting all our schedules so students will be testing without interruptions, and we ask you to do the same. Please schedule any appointments accordingly, so students do not miss any testing time.
