Review:

School to Home Folder: Coming home today with your child will be a large collection of papers and a **Parent/Student Handbook** inside our **School to Home Folder**. Lunches must be dropped off by 10:00am to ensure your child gets his/her lunch. Please know we will not call to the classroom and disrupt instruction to let your child know his/her lunch is here. Your child will simply check the table. Please be sure your child’s name and teacher name is printed on the bag.
